CRESENT MCGAIN lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, gained command with a furlong to run and held sway to the wire. TOP BANKER AL chased the leaders from the outside throughout and finished with good energy. CAMP PENDLETON raced off the leaders from between rivals, moved inside into the lane and finished evenly. COLONEL D. W. was hustled along to raced off the leaders from the inside, angled out into the stretch and also finished evenly in the drive. WHINE AFTER WINE lacked early speed, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole, moved outside through the turn and failed to menace. JIMMY JOE MEEKER stumbled at the start, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. COUGAR BOB hopped at the start, recovered quickly to open a clear lead before going a quarter and weakened after going three furlongs. LOOKS TO KILL raced off the leaders early, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole and did not threaten thereafter.
