Footnotes

DIAMOND PEAK broke sharply to press the pace of OURSHANGHAIEXPRESS from the inside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the three-eighths pole, vied into deep stretch and proved best through the final yards. OURSHANGHAIEXPRESS was away in good order to set a pressured pace from the outside, responded when challenged by the winner nearing the three-eighths marker, vied with that rival but could not match strides late. TAHOE'S PRIZE chased the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to gain in the drive. CRESCENT BAR showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane and finished evenly late. SPIKER raced off the pacesetters throughout and lacked the needed rally. LAACHEM broke in the air, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. PEAKABOOT POSTETTE chased the leaders from the outside for three-quarters and weakened.
