WINNING MACHINE was away alertly to press the pace from between rivals, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the seven-sixteenths marker, gained a slight edge and gamely held that margin to the wire. ROOSTER CITY pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to offer a bid in mid-stretch but could not get by the winner in the drive. PEACEFUL REIGN stalked the pace of the winner from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, moved up for a striking position in the final sixteenth but lacked the needed late response. CONNOR'S BUDDY raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. RED DANCER showed no early speed, saved ground through the second turn, steadied nearing the three-sixteenths pole and did not threaten thereafter. DEVIL CAT M D was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way after going three-quarters. MESSY MARVIN showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. The rider of RED DANCER lodged an objection against CONNOR'S BUDDY concerning the steadying of his mount at the three-sixteenths pole and after reviewing the films the Stewards concluded RED DANCER had came out into the lane and caused his own trouble and made no change.
