Footnotes

FIVE TIMES stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up from between foes to take command nearing the quarter and drew off through the lane while racing in hand. FOOLISH MISS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn, angled in nearing the quarter, was no match for the winner in the drive but finished well to gain the place. LIL SISTER SADIE was away alertly to press the pace of WARREN'S ROCK ART from the outside, moved up to engage that rival after going a half, drifted out into the stretch and gave way gradually in the drive. ROXY SKYLAR showed no early speed, saved ground through the second turn, angled out in mid-stretch and finished evenly. WARREN'S ROCK ART broke sharply to open a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace, responded when challenged by LIL SISTER SADIE nearing the half and weakened after going three-quarters. FLY AWAY was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to menace.
