**Footnotes**

CYBER BELL raced off the leaders early, moved between foes nearing the three-eighths pole, reached the fore with a furlong to run and quickly drew off. CANVASBACK COVE was never far back while racing along the inside, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished well to gain the place. CALIFORNIA COLONEL pressed the pace from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. TAKING LIBERTIES was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear margin nearing the half and gave way through the final furlong. KACTUS RELEVATION lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to menace. CAVEMAN KITCHEN was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and weakened after going three furlongs. LOUDER lagged early, saved ground into the stretch and did not reach contention. SILENT SNOW lacked early foot, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor.
