THE GREAT FACE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, opened a clear lead with seven-sixteenths to run, increased his margin into the lane and was kept to task for a safe margin late. VALENTINE PARADE raced off the pacesetters early while saving ground and finished willingly in the drive to be clearly second best. SANFRAN was void of early speed, raced wide through the second turn and showed some late run. IDABETABUCK raced off the rail throughout and failed to rally. MONEY UP FRONT broke in the air, saved ground into the stretch and did not reach contention. BE A HALO duelled for the lead with the winner for five furlongs, stopped and was eased through the lane.
