**Footnotes**

LA SWING stalked the pace racing along the inside, angled out to make her bid leaving the second turn, forged command entering the stretch, drifted about through the drive and steadied drew clear. KIMI ANNE set the pressured pace racing four wide, opened clear after a half, was unable to match strides with the winner but continued on willingly to clearly prove second best. CAMPIANO QUEEN settled saving ground, angled out to make a steady advance, and was along in time to earn the show. MANZERITA was unhurried early, came four wide to make her rally, but found her best stride too late. NOBLE SPIRES stalked the pace racing along the inside, came three wide to make her bid, was bumped entering the stretch and flattened out thereafter. ALONG CAME LAUREN was unhurried early, got through to make a belated gain, but passed only her tiring rivals. DESIGNED FOR GOLD prompted the pace racing between horses, but came up empty on the second turn and faded. SLEWRANDA pressed the pace racing three wide from between horses for six furlongs and faltered. SHE'S A TOP STAR showed little. ALLIE'S BEEMER chased the pace racing four wide for a half and stopped.
