Footnotes

PONCHO showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and was up in the final yards. BUCKSHOT WEST was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside, responded when set down for the drive and gave way to the winner late. TONY'S LEGACY broke sharply to press the pace from the outside, could not match strides with the winner but finished well to share the place. HE'S ALWAYS RIGHT raced wide through the turns, lacked early speed, angled out into the stretch and finished with some late run. PIRATES DEPUTY raced off the leaders from between foes, moved outside through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. INHOC SIGNO VINCAS lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not threaten. GUSTAVO was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not menace. DRY MAN'S GULCH duelled for the lead from the inside for a half and stopped.
