Footnotes

SUGAR BLOSSOM was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, reached CLEVER CITY with a sixteenth to run and drew clear late. CLEVER CITY raced wide through the first turn, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to take command nearing the quarter, quickly opened a clear margin but could not hold the winner safe through the final yards. DISTURBINGTHEPEACE was bumped at the start, lagged early, saved ground through the turns, angled out into the lane and finished with good late energy. BRAVE JOSIE KATE chased the leaders from the inside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the eleven-sixteenths pole and gave way after going three-quarters. MISS MONY BAGGZ was bumped at the start, chased the leaders early, moved up from between foes to offer a bid nearing the five-eighths marker and also weakened after six furlongs. COUNTRY BABE was bumped at the start, opened a clear lead from the outside before going a quarter, lugged out through the second turn and did not threaten thereafter.
