WEEKENDER stalked the clear pace saving ground, split horses entering the stretch and wore down his foes in a stiff drive. SHARP RAZOR rallied through the turn to range into striking distance, loomed boldly entering the lane but was outkicked. S. S. HAWKEYE made a late rally slipping through in the stretch, and closed willingly. BAY RUNNER rushed to a commanding lead at once, but flattened out suddenly in the upper stretch and gave way. FALSE PASS swung wide entering the stretch, and passed the tiring rivals. WHISPERING PETE chased the runaway pace to the quarter pole, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. EDNEATOR fought against restraint early, but was pulled back, never responded and was outrun.
