ANNIE'S BOU PEEP settled saving ground to the second bend, closed the gap entering the lane, angled out into the stretch and was all out to ware down MRS. PIGGLE WIGGLE in the deep going. MRS. PIGGLE WIGGLE set the pressured pace from the inside, shook clear on the second turn, drifted out entering the lane and grudgingly gave in. BATES MONARCH was unhurried early, drifted out through the first turn, then settled along the inside, made a late rally swinging six wide into the lane to post a mild bid. TWO ELEVEN was carried out early, then settled through the opening half mile, circled five wide through the second turn and made a mild late gain. WEE WILLY GALPIN failed to menace. AUNT POLLY broke in the air and lost ground, rushed to contention on the first turn, but was used up to recover and had little left for the drive. TAJUN steadily dropped out. ROSES TONITE rushed up to press the pace, but was through after a half and stopped.
