Footnotes

WEST SEATTLE BOY lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn, responded to steady urging and was up in the closing strides. TENATIOUS was off a step slow, stalked the leaders from off the rail, moved up to take a slight edge with a sixteenth to run but could not hold the winner safe late. MILITARY DEPUTY stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the quarter, also gained a slight lead and gave way in the drive. DIAMOND INDY went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way after three-quarters. TAHOE BLUES was never far back while racing along the inside and gradually weakened.
