Footnotes

NOOSA BEACH pressed the pace of SIBERIAN COCKTAIL from the inside, moved up to engage that foe nearing the half, opened a clear lead with a quarter to run and held sway to the wire. WASSERMAN was allowed to settle in stride early, saved ground through the turns, angled outside nearing the quarter marker and finished with a steady rally. HE'S ALL HEART was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from between rivals early, moved outside through the second turn and finished with good courage. MARGO'S GIFT chased the leaders from the inside throughout and lacked the needed closing response. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL was bumped at the start, set a pressured pace from the outside, drifted out nearing the quarter and weakened in the drive. SCALDING PASSION was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders throughout and did not reach contention.
