Footnotes

RAINIER ICE stalked the pace of MIDDAS GOLD TOUCH from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge with a furlong to run and steadily drew clear. MIDDAS GOLD TOUCH sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, yielded to the winner in mid-stretch but finished with good courage to be clearly second best. UGOTTABCATTY was never far back while racing along the inside and lacked the needed closing response. TRIBALTIQUE raced off the pacesetters from the outside throughout and failed to rally. WASSERMAN showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. SEMINOLE BRAVE broke sharply to chase the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. ZAGREUS was void of early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention.
