SIXTEEN REASONS was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, turned back the tandem bids from YOU SEND ME and SLAMMIN' KITTY nearing the five-sixteenths marker, vied with YOU SEND ME through a prolonged drive and drew clear through the final yards. YOU SEND ME pressed the pace of the winner from between foes, moved up to engage that rival nearing the five-sixteenths pole, vied into deep stretch but could not match strides late. APPEALING ARTIE was void of early speed, saved ground through the turn and failed to threaten the top pair. STEP AND ONE HALF lacked early foot, avoided fallen foes nearing the quarter and was eased through the lane. MEMO'S STAR raced far back early and was eased after the opening quarter. CHARISMATIC HOPE was never far back, fell over fallen foe nearing the quarter and was walked off. SLAMIN' KITTY pressed the pace of the winner from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the five-sixteenths pole, fell and was vanned off.
