TABLE TOPPER stalked the pace racing three wide, launched his bid entering the stretch, forged a narrow lead inside the sixteenth marker, then was fully extended to prevail. LA HOAGRE was allowed to settle into stride, came four wide to make a bold bid, and was gaining steadily through the drive. STORM BLITZ dueled for the lead racing two wide, opened clear entering the lane, but weakened during the drive and gave way. WABI SABI was slow into stride, swung five wide to make his rally, but found his best stride too late. TROPICAL TOM was hustled along on the inside to attend the pace, but lacked a response when called upon. TSUNAMI WARRIOR dueled for the lead racing along the inside, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. BIG SKY BOY saved ground to no avail. HURRICANE VICTOR rushed to contention from between horses, but came up empty after a half and dropped out.
