CHEEZA KAY broke in stride to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin nearing the quarter and held sway to the wire. LADY ROULETTE was bumped at the start, moved up quickly to press the pace from the outside, could not reach the winner in the drive but finished with good late energy. RAISE THE ANTE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished full of run. KISS EM pressed the pace of the winner from the inside, angled out into the stretch but failed to gain on that rival late. BELLA ANGELINA was never far back while racing from off the rail and finished evenly in the drive. A COURTING VENTURE lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not reach contention. KAMILCHE ROAD was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace.
