STARBIRD ROAD was off a step slow, stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, reached SABERTOOTH nearing the three-sixteenths marker, quickly opened a clear lead and drew off handily for a new track record. SABERTOOTH broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside, was no match for the winner in the drive but finished well to save the place. SLEWICIDE CRUISE showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy. CHICKASAW PARK chased the leaders from the outside for a half and gave way. FREE COCKTAILS dueled for the lead from the inside for a half and weakened. PACKY was away alertly then dropped off the pacesetters while racing from the inside and did not reach contention.
