LIZZY LASS raced off the pacesetters early, angled inside into the lane, reached her stable-mate with a sixteenth to run and quickly drew off for stable bragging rights. PEANUTBUTTER ONIT broke sharply to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear margin nearing the three-eighths pole and yielded through the final yards. PURE ARTISTRY chased the leaders from off the rail throughout, could not gain on the top pair in the drive but finished with good courage. MARGARET B was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. SHUMKA'S LULLABY showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. CHASING DEMONS was void of early foot, raced far wide through the turn and failed to menace. SARAH SWEETIE broke awkwardly, moved up quickly to press the pace from the inside, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole and did not threaten thereafter. SAILING ON BY showed brief speed from between rivals and weakened.
