Footnotes

HE'S ALL HEART sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace, turned back the bid of WASSERMAN nearing the half, re-cleared, was well rated and drew off through the lane as the handiest of winners. NEWFOUND MAN was allowed to settle in stride early, raced far wide through the second turn, reached a contending position into the lane, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. WASSERMAN was never far back, moved up from the outside to offer a bid nearing the half, gave way but held on to save the show. AARON THE BARON broke in the air, rushed to contend, chased the winner from the outside and weakened after going six furlongs. SNOW ON THE RIVER lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
