MAGIC CODE stalked the issue racing three deep, ranged up to assume command with a quarter to run, edged clear entering the lane and was kept to task to hold sway. DYNA'S CLUB settled saving ground while close up, angled out in the upper stretch and finished well in a game effort. DEPUTY SUE was allowed to settle racing four wide, rallied through the second bend to move into striking distance, loomed large at the head of the lane but failed to sustain the drive. PURLS LEDGEND was taken back at once, made a mild rally swinging five wide into the stretch, offering a late gain. IGNITE THE PASSION settled in mid pack along the inside, but went evenly and failed to menace. FLEET PACIFIC pressed the tempo from the outside, but was collared between horses nearing the quarter pole and dropped out. BRIARTIC BLAST failed to respond, and was no factor. GUINEVERE set the pressured pace to the quarter pole, then came up empty entering the stretch and stopped.
