Footnotes

DON'T SAY THAT showed no early speed, raced far wide through the second turn, reached the fore with a furlong to run and held GENERAL JOE safe to the wire. GENERAL JOE hesitated at the break, moved up quickly to race just off the leaders from between foes, responded when set down for the drive and gave way grudgingly to the winner in the drive. NACHES DEPUTY was void of early speed, lacked racing room approaching the stretch, angled outside nearing the furlong marker and finished with good energy. COMMANDING SPIRIT was pinched back at the start, moved up to set a pressured pace from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. TOP THREAT saved ground throughout to no avail. GENTLE GEORGE broke sharply to press the pace from the inside and gave way after three-quarters. REASON TO RECKON hesitated at the break, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. GOTADOWATSISDIDTOO was never far back while racing from between rivals and weakened after six furlongs.
