LET ME GET MY HAT went to the front at once, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and held off MONDAY MYSTERY in the drive to gamely prevail. MONDAY MYSTERY chased the winner from the inside, steadied nearing the five-eighths pole, angled out into the lane, moved up to LET ME GET MY HAT with a furlong to run but could not get by that rival in the drive. SICY was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. JOYOUS EVENT lacked early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with some late run. LADY VITESSE was void of early foot, raced wide through the turn and did not reach contention. JAZZOOM chased the leaders from off the rail and weakened after going a half. SICILY GRACE raced far back throughout. The rider of MONDAY MYSTERY lodged an objection against LET ME GET MY HAT concerning the steadying of his mount at the five-eighths pole and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
