BERNIE WHITE SHOES was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside with INTENSIVE, disposed of that rival with a quarter to run, quickly opened a commanding lead and was ridden out to maintain that margin. WEST SEATTLE BOY lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and finished with good energy. WALLY BALLOU raced far back early, moved outside for the drive and finished with good late speed. BIG HERO saved ground throughout and finished evenly. INTENSIVE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the outside and gave way after three-quarters. MILITARY DEPUTY was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor. POINTE BIRDS showed brief speed and stopped.
