ROYAL SHRINE was never far back while racing along the inside, moved up to engage HILLYBILLY CADILLAC nearing the sixteenth pole and proved best over that rival in the closing yards. HILLBILLY CADILLAC was away alertly to press the pace of JUST ZOOM WILL DO from the outside, moved up to take command inside the quarter, responded when challenged by the winner late but could not hold that rival safe. WILLIE THE FOX was void of early foot, angled out approaching the stretch and finished with good late energy. WILD HOSS showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and found his best stride late. OUR MARSHAL CAHILL was never far back while racing from the outside and gradually gave way. SWISS LIGHTNING lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to menace. MR. TOP KAT pressed the pace from between rivals for a half and weakened. JUST ZOOM WILL DO set a pressured pace from off the rail and weakened after going a half.
