OUR PRETTY WOMAN broke sharply to duel for the early advantage with MISS KELSO from the outside, disposed of that rival nearing the five-sixteenths marker, increased her margin into the lane and won with complete authority. STEFFIE DU BOIS was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the outside, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. KILAUEA was never far back while racing from off the rail, steadied from between rivals nearing the three-sixteenths marker, angled inside and finished with good courage. LADY IN SILK lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further into the stretch and finished with a late bid. MILIEUX was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the inside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. UNDERFUNDED FUN was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention. MISS KELSO was bumped at the start, dueling from the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half. SHE'S MY FAVORITE chased the leaders from the outside for a half and weakened. TESIO'S THEORY hopped at the start, raced wide through the turn and gradually weakened. VALENTINA STORM was off slow and lagged throughout.
