AGOODLAWYER WILLDO was bumped at the break, stalked the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the quarter, reached the fore inside the eighth pole and quickly drew off. INQUIRY MISS was away alertly to press the pace of KAMILCHE GOLD from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the five-sixteenths pole, vied into mid-stretch and gave way to the winner. KAMILCHE GOLD broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged by INQUIRY MISS nearing the five-sixteenths marker, vied and gave way through the final furlong. SOCIETY GIRL was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and finished evenly in the drive. STRANGE LUCK was bumped at the break, raced off the leaders from the outside and was not a factor. PREMO JEWEL stumbled at the start and was bumped, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
