BLAME THE JOCKEY raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn, engaged CAT ON BASE with a furlong to run and proved best over that rival through the final yards. CAT ON BASE was fractious at the gate, set a pressured pace from the inside, responded when challenged by the winner nearing the eighth pole and grudgingly gave way to that rival late. KOALA BEACH raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good late energy. RESCUE PLAN chased the leaders from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. GOLD HARBOR lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. HOWMUCHISIT was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, gave way in the drive, fell while pulling up and was vanned off. J. H. COMMANDER was fractious at the gate, clipped heels at the break and lagged throughout.
