QUEEN SENSATION sprinted clear at once, raced off the rail while setting the pace and drew off through the lane. FIND YOUR SPOT hesitated at the break, raced wide through the turn, could not gain on the winner in the drive but finished with good energy to be clearly second best. K K'S WONDERWOMAN was never far back while racing from off the rail, reached a striking position in mid-stretch but lacked the needed closing response. TRULY A GEM lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and failed to threaten. SOMETIMES A LADY broke sharply to chase the winner from the outside for a half and weakened.
