CURVITUDE was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the inside, angled out nearing the five-sixteenths pole and again into the lane, reached the leaders inside the furlong marker and quickly drew off. KRAIN CORNER hopped at the start and was bumped, dueled for the lead from the inside and yielded to the winner late. GAVINRYAN showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. THIS LAD IS GOLD lacked early foot, raced far wide through the turn and also finished with good energy. ALFONSO THE GREAT dueled for the lead from the outside and gave way through the final furlong. PROSPECTOROV was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the outside throughout and failed to rally. SONAR EXPRESS broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside and weakened after going a half.
