ROARIFIED was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear margin nearing the half, increased that advantage into the lane and was ridden out to the wire. LILLY'S A JEWEL lacked early speed, angled out approaching the stretch, could not reach the winner in the drive but finished with good energy. GRAND BAYLEE was void of early foot, raced wide through the second turn and finished with a steady bid. PICKLED AGAIN showed no early speed, saved ground throughout and found her best stride late. CATHERINE Z'S HOPE was away alertly to press the pace from the outside and gave way after going three-quarters. FEELS LIKE RAIN chased the leaders from the far outside and weakened after going five furlongs. ZIPPIN E raced off the leaders from between foes and gradually weakened. The trainer of GRAND BAYLEE lodged an objection against LILLY'S A JEWEL and after reviewing the films the stewards made no change.
