**Footnotes**

BIG DADDY'S VISION stalked the pace of CASTLE PINES from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the quarter, opened clear lead in mid-stretch and held off the closing SILVER SNEAKERS to prevail. SILVER SNEAKERS lacked early speed, raced far wide through the second turn and finished with good late energy. ARMED SERVICE was void of early foot, raced wide through both turns and finished with good late speed. PRINCE GIDDYUP showed no early speed, saved ground into the stretch, angled out with a furlong to run and finished willingly. BEBE CHRISSY was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out approaching the stretch and failed to gain in the drive. I AM THOR chased the leaders from the outside and gave way after going three-quarters. CASTLE PINES sprinted clear at once, saved ground while setting the pace and gave way to the winner after going six furlongs. GAME EMPEROR raced off the pacesetters early, angled out nearing the quarter and failed to menace. ORLANDO XPRESS raced off the leaders throughout and gradually weakened. SARGANIS raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the second turn and did not rally. BAD AS CAN BE was off slow, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor.
