BUCKLE was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead nearing the quarter and steadily drew off. CRESENT MCGAIN was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, was no match for the winner in the drive but finished well to be clearly second best. ONCE pressed the pace from the inside throughout and gave way in the drive. TREE TOP ducked in the gap at the start, advance from the inside for a contending position, angled out nearing the quarter and finished evenly late. OVER AND UNDER was away alertly then quickly dropped back, raced between foes through the back-stretch, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths pole and did not threaten in the drive. EATONVILLE WILDCAT was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, steadied nearing the five-sixteenths marker and did not menace thereafter. BEER NOSE was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten.
