CARRY ON JOHN was away alertly to stalk the pace of ROYAL GAME from the inside, moved up to take command into the lane, opened a clear lead and was fully extended to hold SIBERIAN COCKTAIL safe late. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out into the lane and was gaining on the winner late. DRESS CODE was off a step slow and bumped, raced off the leaders from the inside and finished with good energy to also be gaining late. ZAGREUS showed no early speed, moved outside through the turn and finished with good late speed. ABSOLUTELY COOL chased the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. CLEAR TO CANADA lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. ROYAL GAME went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, increased his advantage through the turn and stopped after going a half.
