Footnotes

BUDS A FLYIN broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the outside, opened a clear lead into the lane and held sway to the wire. IT'S OUR PLEASURE lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. MEMORIES FOREVER was never far back while racing along the inside, steadied nearing the three-eighths pole, angled out nearing the quarter and finished with a steady rally. TOUGH GOLD raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and finished some late run. RAINIER was away alertly to stalk the leaders from the outside and gave way in the drive. CASTLE ROMEO lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace. DICEY DEAL raced off the leaders from between foes gradually gave way. BUDDY DAVE showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and was not a factor. FAST TRADE pressed the pace from the inside for a half and weakened.
