SNOWBOUND MARQUITA was away alertly to set a pressured pace, opened a clear margin with a furlong to run and held PERFECT PIE safe in the drive to prevail. PERFECT PIE broke sharply to chase the winner from between foes but could not get by that rival in the dive. SUN CITY raced just off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with good energy. SHAMEONYA lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, moved up for a contending position in mid-stretch but failed to gain late. MONTELENA pressed the pace from the inside for three furlongs and gave way. HAVE'N A WILD TIME lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not menace. LIZZY LASS showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not reach contention. SHE'S ONLY A DREAM raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened.
