HEZA WITCH DOCTOR was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take command inside the quarter and held off UNTILIFINDYOU in the drive to prevail. UNTILIFINDYOU raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. GO WITH GUSTO steadied at the start, lagged early, raced far wide through the turn, came in to bump rival nearing the sixteenth pole and finished full of run when clear. BUDDY DAVE was bumped at the start, raced off the pacesetters from the outside and finished willingly in the drive. MALIBU RUM raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and found his best stride late. VEGAS FLYER raced off the pacesetters from the inside, angled out in mid-stretch but failed to gain in the drive. U CAN'T TELL ME NO broke sharply to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way through the final furlong. ROYAL SHRINE was void of early speed while racing from between rivals, moved outside through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch but failed to menace. CHET THE JET was bumped at the start, lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn, was bumped again nearing the sixteenth pole and did not reach contention. ONLY BE CAUSE was bumped at the start, raced off the leaders from the inside and gradually weakened. KOOL COMIC was never far back, steadied nearing the quarter and did not menace thereafter. VADERATOR bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside, steadied nearing the eighth pole while retreating and continued to give way.
