CLASSIELYTE broke sharply to set a pressured pace from mid-track, opened a clear lead nearing the three-eighths marker, drifted out through the lane and held the closers safe late. MUSICAL TRICK was never far back while racing along the inside, could not reach the winner in the drive but finished with good courage. BIJOU BARRISTER lacked early speed, saved ground through the turn, angled out into the stretch and finished full of run. HIGHDLBURG was away alertly to press the pace from the far outside and gave way in the drive. SNOW ON THE RIVER raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and did not threaten. CYBER BELL was off slow, raced wide through the turn and did not menace. LEROI VICTOR raced off the pacesetters from the outside throughout and failed to rally. POLO BENDER chased the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half.
