HE'S ALWAYS RIGHT lacked early speed, raced off the rail into the lane, moved up to take command with a sixteenth to run and steadily drew clear. FORT YATES was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out into the lane and was up for the place. BLACKJACK KETCHUM was away alertly to set a pressured pace from the inside, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and gave way in the drive. HE'S A BARN RAT lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, angled inside in mid-stretch and finished with some late run. D DEVIL raced just off the leaders, angled out with a furlong to run but lacked the needed closing response. SUMMER SHOOT raced off the leaders early, moved far outside through the turn and did not threaten. FATMANSTEW was hustled along to press the pace from the outside and gave way after going a half. READY SAY GO raced far back throughout.
