K LEA ROAD was never far back, raced wide through the turn, moved up to gain command with a furlong to run and steadily drew clear. LILLY FA POOTZ pressed the pace from the outside throughout, could not match strides with the winner in the drive but finished well to be clearly second best. ROXY SKYLAR lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn, moved between foes late and finished with good courage. WAVE HER ON bobbled at the start, raced wide through the turn and finished with some late run. SNOOTY GAL was away alertly to duel for the lead from the inside, gave way through the final furlong, drifted inward nearing the sixteenth pole and continued to give way. PERHAPS PERHAPS raced off the leaders throughout and failed to threaten. PETE'S GLORY GIRL showed no early speed, saved ground into the lane, steadied nearing the sixteenth pole and lost chance for a better placing. RUN SAVIO RUN was away alertly to duel for the lead from the outside and weakened after going three furlongs. PRETTY CAPABLE chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after going a half. The Stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the steady of PETE'S GLORY GIRL at the sixteenth pole and after reviewing the films concluded SNOOTY GAL had caused the incident and was disqualified and placed seventh.
