### Footnotes

OLYMPIC LIGHTS was off a step slow, moved up quickly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, opened a clear lead with a furlong to run and held sway to the wire with little urging. SO WHATABOUT lacked early speed, raced off the rail through the turn, angled outside nearing the quarter and finished with good energy. VICKYS FAST BOY was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside and lacked the needed closing response. EIGHTY EIGHT pressed the pace from the outside and gave way after going five furlongs. RED REDDING showed no early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not threaten. HICKORY ROAD broke slow and out, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention.
