SNOOPER DAUPER broke sharply then dropped off the pacesetters, moved outside through the turn, reached his stable-mate with a furlong to run and quickly drew off as a handy winner. KRAIN CORNER was away alertly to set a pressured pace from off the rail, was no match for the winner in the drive but finished well to save the pace. DEAD EYE was off a step slow, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and finished with good late energy. MYTH SEEKER pressed the pace of KRAIN CORNER from the outside, moved up to engage that rival nearing the three-eighths pole and gave way in the drive. CHUPETES lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. EAGLE BUTTE raced off the pacesetters from the outside and gradually weakened. ASUMMERPROSPECT pressed the pace from the inside, checked nearing the three-eighths marker and weakened thereafter.
