COASTAL KING lacked early speed, raced wide into the lane, reached the leaders inside the sixteenth pole, quickly opened a clear lead and was in hand late. WOW NOW showed no early speed, angled outside in mid-stretch and finished full of run. COUNTRY COP was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to engage nearing the three-sixteenths marker and gave way late. NOSIR raced just off the pacesetters early, angled inside nearing the eight pole and showed some late interest. RENO RINGO pressed the pace from the outside and weakened after a half. ROB'S AFLEET was bumped at the start, saved ground into the stretch and failed menace. IM PURE COUNTRY broke sharply to set a pressured pace and gave way after five furlongs. TOUTLELEW pressed the pace from the outside, was bumped while weakening in mid-stretch and did not menace thereafter. RENEGADE CIELO was never far back, raced wide through the turn and weakened.
