**Footnotes**

CHICK MAGNET was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, moved up to take command after the opening quarter, was headed in mid-stretch by MILITARY DEPUTY but responded to steady handling and proved best in a stiff drive. MILITARY DEPUTY was never far back, moved outside through the second turn, offered a bid with a furlong to run but was unable to retain his edge late. LAST OUTPOST was void of early speed, angled out for racing room inside the eighth pole and was gaining late. CHUCKALEE raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly. WANT TO TRAVEL raced wide through the first turn and failed to rally. CORNER KICK broke sharply to open a clear lead before going a quarter and weakened soon after. SEVEN EAGLES lacked early speed, raced off the rail throughout and did not threaten. GOLD HUMMER raced wide through the second turn and gradually weakened. TAKIN DEAD AIM chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after six furlongs. REGAL SPIRIT showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and did not offer a bid.
