POLO BENDER was away alertly to duel for the lead racing along the inside, shook clear leaving the turn, and was ridden out to increase his advantage. WASSERMAN settled racing in hand, came four wide to make a late rally, and finished willingly to earn the place. STARBIRD ROAD stalked the pace racing along the inside, angled out to make a bid racing three wide, but lacked the needed late response. BRIARTIC GOLD was allowed to settle into stride, came three wide to make a mild rally from between horses, but failed to seriously threaten. MARVA JEAN dueled for the lead racing two wide, but faltered from between horses entering the stretch and faded. DIAMOND VIEW was taken in hand and reserved off of the pace, angled in to save ground, got through entering the stretch, but lacked a response when called upon.
