Footnotes

TELESCOPIC saved ground racing along the inside behind the early pacesetter, raced three wide in the turn, edged up to leader mid stretch, dug in, took command and held clear. MISTY LADY took command early and led by a slight margin, continued to lead heading into the turn, raced near the rail in the stretch and could not hold off TELESCOPIC in the late drive. KENZIE MARIA stalked the early pacesetters, steadily advanced position, raced within striking distance of leader in the turn, continued bid in the stretch but did not have enough late to hold on. MOON LARRY settled in behind the early front runners, made a bid heading into the turn and had a mild gain in the stretch. IT'S A ECHO RUMOR hopped at the break, raced near the back of the pack, steadily advanced position but was not enough to make an impact. RUN MATTY raced near the back of the pack in the early going, steadily advanced position but was not enough. JET FUEL made a brief bid racing between rivals in the early going and had nothing left late. SKIP THRU TIME raced up close and chased the early speed and steadily began to weaken after a half. MELBA'S ROSE raced near the inside and was no factor. EARLY CLOSING made a brief bid early racing right behind the speed and steadily faded after a half. GOOD THEATER showed little throughout.
