Footnotes

JOLLY ROCKET settled in behind the early pacesetters, began to advance position heading into the turn, raced four wide at the top of the lane, continued bid along the outside in the stretch, took command and held clear late. EASY STING stalked the early front runners, made a bid heading into the turn, angled out six wide in the stretch, continued along the outside and was second best. EARTHQUAKE stalked the early pacesetters, raced three wide in the turn, raced within striking distance in the stretch and had no late kick in the drive. NICODEMUS tracked the early front runners, edged up to within striking distance of the leaders but did not have enough in the drive. BROADWAY STYLE dueled for the early lead with ROUGHHOUSE while racing on the outside, they continued to match strides until the top of the lane and had nothing left for the drive. KELA'S CAJUN raced five wide in the turn and was no threat. MOST WANTED MAN made a brief bid between rivals in the early going and had nothing left late. ROUGHHOUSE dueled along the inside with BROADWAY STYLE, they matched strides until the top of the lane and began to tire entering the stretch. COOL MINUTE MAN raced evenly near the back of the pack and was no factor.
