BONDOCK BORN stalked the early pacesetters, steadily advanced position, raced five wide in the turn, edged up to take the lead by a slight margin in the top of the lane, continued to dig in the stretch and held clear under a driving finish. JOHN LOUISMINISTER was unhurried early and settled in behind the front runners, saved ground along the inside, made a bid at the top of the lane, angled to the outside in the stretch and rallied to get up for second. JANIE'S CHAMP settled in behind the early pacesetters, steadily advanced position, raced wide in the far turn, continued bid along the outside and improved position in the stretch. MR. CLASSIC SPIRIT stalked the early pacesetters, made a bid heading into the turn and failed to sustain bid in the late stretch. WILDCAT'S TUNE tracked the early front runners, made a bid and took command, continued to lead by a slight margin but had nothing left in the drive. TRIBUTE'S

BEST ONE showed early speed away from the gate and steadily faded. ZUPPARDO'SALLUSION settled in behind the early front runners, made a bid and slightly advanced position and came up empty in the drive. MIDNITE SHARKBITE raced near the back of rivals early, slightly improved position but was not enough to be a threat. LUKETHELKE made a brief bid in the early going and steadily weakened. RITAS CROWNRESERVE raced in the back of the pack early and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. ENTEPRENEUR TO raced in the middle of rivals early and had nothing left late. FLY FOR JODY lacked response throughout. CARD DEALER showed early speed and gave way. JOE'SDARKANDSTORMY raced near the back early and was pulled up.
