Footnotes

SLIGEUX BEAU raced up close tracking IRISH STORM CHASER, made a bid heading into the turn, edged up to leader in the top of the lane, they briefly matched strides in the stretch, dug in and prevailed in final strides. IRISH STORM CHASER took command early and lead by a slight margin, continued the leader heading into the turn, felt pressure from SLIGEUX BEAU in the upper stretch and they began to duel, raced along the inside of rival and could not hold on in final strides. WHO DAT GHOST raced near the back of the pack early, steadily advanced position, raced three wide in the turn and had a mild rally in the stretch. DAKOTA COMET was unhurried early and settled in behind the early pacesetters, made a bid heading into the turn and improved position in the stretch. ART'S GUARANTEE raced up close and tracked the top two pacesetters, continued bid heading into the turn but had nothing left in the stretch. GENEROUS OFFER raced near the back of the pack, raced three wide and was no menace. REGLAS DEL DIA made a brief bid and failed to be a threat. MCMOE made a brief bid between rivals in the early going and steadily weakened in the drive. WAIMEA'S DIAMOND raced near the inside and was never a factor. CONCHOS CHINOS made a brief bid and raced within striking distance of the leaders and steadily faded. KISATCHIE RUN raced evenly near the back of the pack and had no response when asked.
