GOLD BAY raced up close and tracked the top two pacesetters, made a bid and began to advance position along the outside, edged up to leaders heading into the turn, took command and remained clear. BATTLE BOOGIE was unhurried early and settled in behind the front runners, made a bid and began to steadily advance position, raced three wide in the turn and finished second best. COLLEGE BOUND KATE settled in near the back of the pack early, made a bid in the upper stretch and rallied to be up show. CRAZY COUNTESS showed early speed and took command by a slight margin, continued bid along the rail heading into the turn but had nothing left for the drive. GOLDEN POLICY raced up close right behind the early pacesetter, continued bid between rivals in the turn but began to weaken in the drive. HELLA BELLA stalked the early front runners, raced within striking distance heading into the turn but had nothing left late. DOC OF THE BAY raced in the back of rivals early and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. ONE MORE FAPIANO made a brief bid between rivals in the early going and steadily began to fade. TIME OF THE NIGHT faded to the back of the pack and lacked a late response.
